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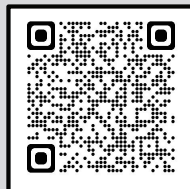
Documents Needed for Application Submission:

1. Proof of Age: Birth Certificate, Birth Information provided by the Courts/DSS, or Birth Letter from Hospital.
2. Verification of Household Income: 2 most current pay stubs, W-2, 1040, or Child Support if you receive TANF or SSI, please provide award letter.
3. Proof of Residency, confirm with school division for acceptable forms.
4. Parent/Guardian Government Issued Photo ID.
5. Custody Papers, if applicable.
6. IEP Documentation, if applicable.

**If you have a current physical immunization and/or Dental Exam, please provide at the time you submit supporting documents.*

HEAD START

3 – 4 years of age

Child must be of age by September 30th

- ❖ Family income is at or below 100% of federal poverty guidelines.
- ❖ Family is homeless.
- ❖ Family is eligible for public assistance (TANF, SSI, or SNAP).
- ❖ Child is in foster care.

VIRGINIA PRESCHOOL INITIATIVE (VPI)

Public School Preschool

**4 years of age*

*Some VPI programs serve children 3 years of age
Child must be of age by September 30th

- ❖ Family income is at or below 200% of federal poverty guidelines.
- ❖ Family is homeless.
- ❖ Parents/Guardians did not complete high school.
- ❖ Child has an identified disability or is receiving services through early intervention.

MIXED DELIVERY

Child Care Centers

3 – 4 years of age

Child must be of age by September 30th

- ❖ Family income is at or below 200% of federal poverty guidelines.
- ❖ Family is homeless.
- ❖ Parents/Guardians did not complete high school.
- ❖ Child has an identified disability or is receiving services through early intervention.
- ❖ Child is determined eligible by local eligibility criteria that are specific to the Mixed Delivery service area.
